Upon the request of John Taylor, Presiding Limited Jurisdiction Judge in Mohave County, and in accordance with provisions of the Arizona Code of Judicial Administration, effective January 1, 2009;

IT IS ORDERED that defensive driving schools certified by the Arizona Supreme Court are authorized to grant a onetime 30 day continuance per case. The student shall complete the course at least seven days prior to their new court date to allow the defensive driving school time to transmit completion information to the courts.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the school shall notify the court of jurisdiction of any continuance it grants within seven days.
