School Mission Statement

The Opportunity School provides an “**opportunity**” for non-detained youth who have been expelled or long-termed suspended from the Kingman Unified School District to obtain school credit. This educational setting is housed in the Juvenile Justice Support Center and is accredited by the Arizona Department of Education (ADE). These students attend school 4 hours a day, 5 days a week and receive individualized educational instruction in their own grade level. Students can obtain a GED or earn credits towards graduation requirements from the Kingman Unified School District.

Youth 12 years of age or older are eligible to apply for admission. They are required to obey all rules and complete all assignments in a timely manner.

The Opportunity School provides:

- Computer-based instruction that meets Arizona State Standards
- Testing for grade level placement
- Individualized instruction for all students
- Educational course work that prepares students to pass the GED exam
- Life skills instruction
- Transfer of school credits upon completion of semester or credit recovery requirements



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
