Mission Statement

The mission of Hope Garden is to provide trauma informed, evidenced based, substance abuse treatment to probation youth in our community. Hope Garden builds resilient families by providing structured care and teaching essential skills using a holistic approach to foster all-encompassing change.



Vision

Youth and families receiving treatment at Hope Garden will remain substance free, engage in pro-social behaviors, cultivate healthy families, and sustain positive change for future generations.

Increased Family Engagement

One benefit of having a local program is the ability to offer a substantial family component. Families will be offered a minimum of 8 hours a week of involvement through groups, individual sessions, family sessions and visitation with the child. The capability to address the family unit in its entirety will provide for a much larger margin of success, allowing for Family System Change.

Evidence shows that providing transitional care, promoting family engagement, and building resiliency contributes to lower recidivism, all of which are the mission of Hope Garden.

Collaborative Approach to Change

A team approach to services will be used, in the treatment and case planning processes through weekly staffing. This collaborative method is designed to increase positive behaviors and responsibility to criminogenic risks and needs, while decreasing barriers to success.

Hope Garden aligns with Chief Justice Brutinel's agenda of repurposing juvenile detention center space to better serve juveniles within their communities. Space inside the Juvenile Justice Support Center was repurposed and redesigned to promote a healing environment.
